Notes:

- *Pupils at Lyndhurst are studying Spanish for the second year. The curriculum is being rolled out over a four year period.
- In 2019-20, the ILP *Pharaohs* will replace one of the Science units in order to fulfil the NC requirement to study a non-European Ancient Civilisation – Egyptians already covered by current Year 3 and Year 4. This consequence of this will be that there is another Science unit which will need to be covered discretely.
- During *Allotment* (Summer 1), ensure that *Understanding Seasonality* is given appropriate coverage.
- Opportunities for Music in both *Peasants, Princes and Pestilence* and *Stargazers* need to be fully exploited.
