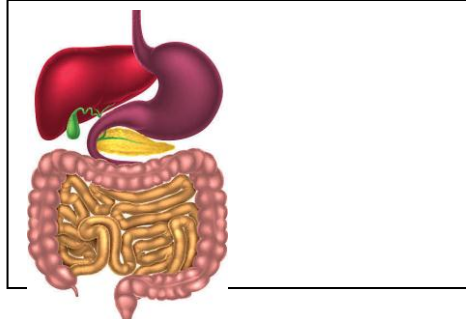


Our Year 4 theme for this half term is:
