We are learning...

English

- To identify and name the key features of a non-chronological report.
- To write our own non-chronological report on a specific predator.
- To read a range of non-fiction texts, looking at specific language choices and structure.

Science

- To compare and contrast food chains and the diets of different animals and decide ways of grouping them according to what they eat.
- To explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.
- To investigate the function of skeletons and muscles in humans and animals.

R.E.

- To explore the suffering depicted in the Easter story and discuss the significance to Christians.

Art

- To use a range of techniques and materials to create a predator inspired, mixed media portrait.

Maths

- To measure, compare, add and subtract lengths (m/cm/mm).
- To measure the perimeter of simple 2-D shapes.
- To continue to revisit and learn our multiplication tables.

Computing

- To use the internet safely and purposefully to gather information.
- To select the appropriate program to present data.

Geography

- To use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries/ continents and describe features studied.

P.E.

- To play competitive games such as football.
- To learn and apply basic principles suitable for attacking and defending.
- To move in a variety of ways exploring symmetry and asymmetry.
