


- An update from Mrs Anderson (Executive Headteacher)

What have we done as leaders ...

- Introduced a new format for end of year reports to parents which are more personalised to each child.
- Organised Transition Week so all children got to move up to their new classes & meet the staff they will be working with.
- Booked the first residential trip in a number of years, so 89 of next year's Yr 6 are off to the Isle of Wight for 3 days in September.
- Undertaken training in a new online system that we are going to use to keep our Safeguarding records up to date & highly secure.
- Reviewed our assessment system to make it easier for everyone to understand.
- Ensured that we are fully staffed for September & that the quality of teaching & learning is now always Good or better.
- Reported on our improved SATs results in all areas to King's Group Academies.
